

GRANITE BUSHROCKS

Single or double,
randomly placed.
Typically 3 ash
interments per
linear metre.
Placed on outer
edge of all garden
beds.



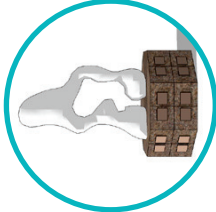
GRANITE PLINTH

Straight and
sloping edging,
located along the
secondary paths.



SCULPTURES

Contemporary
sculptures on
octagonal granite
pedestal.
Ash memorial
available within the
granite base.



MAIN PATH

Permeable concrete
paving to minimise
impact on existing
trees.
Colour to match
existing concrete
paving.

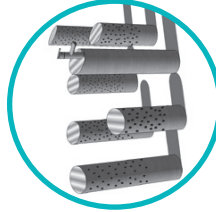

smaller spaces.



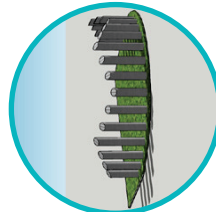
EDGING
