




National Population Growth 1972 - 2016






Components of annual population growth (a)(b), Australia


Population change, Age group - 1998 to 2018








Annual change in Estimated Resident Population (ERP)







Birthplace, 2016








Northern Beaches Council, Overseas arrivals to Australia between 2011 and 2016





Historical migration flows, Northern Beaches Council area, 2011-2016







Change in age structure - service age groups, 2011 to 2016










Change in occupation of employment, 2011 to 2016






Industry sector



Employment capacity by industry 2017/18




















Age structure - five year age groups, 2016





Housing tenure, 2016






Future assumptions:












Age structure - five year age groups, 2016



Change in age structure - five year age groups, 1991 to 2016






Northern Beaches Council, Vacant dwellings, 2016, Enumerated




