


National Population Growth 1972 - 2016



Components of annual population growth (a)(b), Australia




Population change, Age group - 1998 to 2018











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Birthplace, 2016









Change in age structure - service age groups, 2011 to 2016




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The Suburb Lifecycle



Change in occupation of employment, 2011 to 2016



Change in employment (total) by industry, 2012/13 to 2017/18





Employment capacity by industry 2017/18







Forecast population, households and average household size















Change in number of bedrooms per dwelling, 2011 to 2016


Housing tenure, 2016



Future assumptions:

- Low to moderate level of infill development (4-11 dwellings per annum)
- No change in Non-private dwellings
- Some attraction of families (0-9 and 30-44 years)
- Large loss of young adults (18-29 years), mostly home leavers accessing affordable housing, employment and education opportunities elsewhere
- Small loss of empty-nesters (65-74 years)







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Age structure - five year age groups, 2016




Change in age structure - five year age groups, 1991 to 2016



Vacant dwellings, 2016






