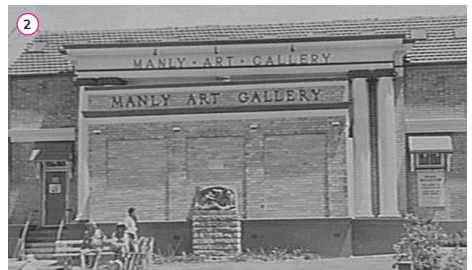
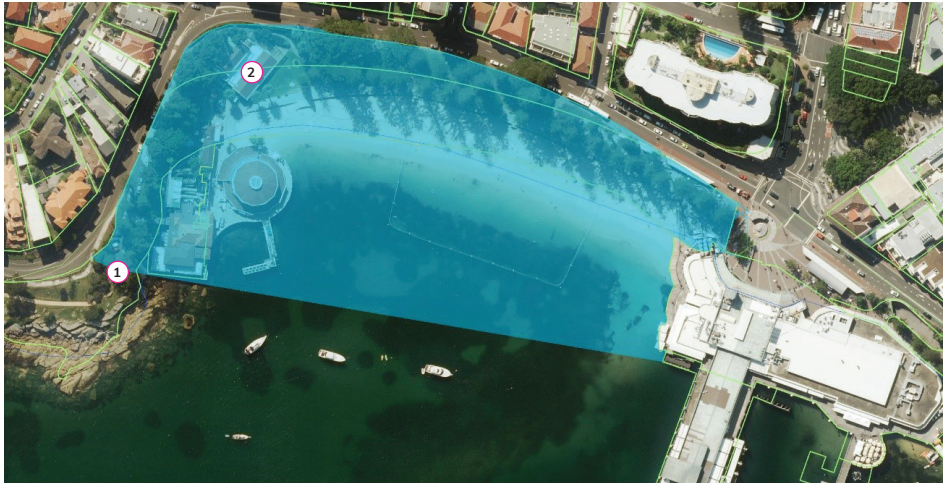
The Heritage Activation Plan aims to:

Stretching from Manly Wharf around to the Manly Pavilion, the area includes a number of land owners including Northern Beaches Council, Crown land (managed by Northern Beaches Council) and Roads and Maritime Services (The Manly Pavilion, Aquarium and Ferry Wharf).
