That Council:

- A. Approve increased funding for capital and management improvements to UDEAs across the LGA with the allocation of \$100,000 per year for the next four years in Council's annual budget for improvements as outlined in this report.
- B. Approve the preparation of an integrated policy for UDEAs and dog management for the Northern Beaches LGA, requiring the new policy address:
 - a. the issue of the current trial (UDEAs) as discussed in this report
 - b. the issues discussed in this report including Mackerel Beach, McCarrs Creek Reserve, Lagoon Park and the management of professional dog walkers.
- C. Endorse the development and implementation of dog education and training programs by Council as part of this process.
- D. Begin a public consultation process with a view to having the following reserves declared as UDEAs.
 - 1. Warriewood Valley Detention Basin, Prosperity Parade Warriewood
 - Avalon Beach Reserve Avalon , adjacent to Central Road. and west of the drainage canal
 - 3. Munnumba Reserve. Munnumba Avenue Belrose
 - 4. South Creek Reserve South Creek Road. Wheeler Heights
- E. Staff review the adequacy of Lagoon Park Queenscliff to function as a UDEA and engage with the community with a view to possibly rescinding the declaration or introducing restricted hours of usage as used in some other of council's UDEAs.
