

## CONCEPT DESIGN FEATURES

### Manly Scenic Walkway Northern Entry

- 1 - Construct new widened coloured concrete entry and access path (1.5m wide) and Fibre Reinforced Plastic (FRP) stair access including viewing platform with curved seat and resting mid-landing

### Picnic Facilities

- 2 - Reconfigure and upgrade existing picnic facilities including new table settings, BBQ (double hot-plate), bin station and sandstone seat walling;
- 3 - Upgrade and relocate tap with dog-drinking bowl to edge of new garden area away from food preparation facilities;


### Viewing Space

- 4 - Proposed viewing / heritage interpretation space to recognise the site's significant history. To include sandstone flag paving & seat wall, relocating existing heritage plaque & plinth and incorporating Interpretation signage;

### Main Grassed Open Space

- 5 - Undertake irrigation upgrade, minor works for addressing ponding & maintenance regime to aid upkeep of grassed areas
