



Proposed Shared Path - 2.5m Wide

Project Information:

Council has been successful in obtaining funding through the *Federal Stimulus - School Infrastructure Program* to develop safer pedestrian and bicycle routes connecting to Wakehurst Public School.

This project aims to upgrade the existing footpath on the northern side of Glen Street between Forest Way and Pringle Avenue to a 2.5m wide shared path with safer crossing treatments at Wanaka Place and Forest Glen Crescent to provide greater accessibility for our community to walk, use prams, wheelchairs, scooters and ride a bicycle.

This project is in line with Council's *Move - Northern Beaches Transport Strategy* and the *Northern Beaches Bike Plan*.
