Background	<p>We are proposing to grant a road reserve lease for another five (5) years to the owner/s of 1 Rowe Street, Freshwater.</p> <p>The purpose of the proposed lease is for the encroachment of a retaining wall and metal shed on the road reserve of Oliver Street, Freshwater.</p> <p>The public notice is in accordance with Section 154 of the <i>Roads Act 1993</i>.</p>
Total number of submissions	Nil.
Summary of findings	No submissions were received. As such, Council will proceed with granting the road reserve as notified.
Engagement approach	<p>The engagement was planned, implemented and reported in accordance with the Northern Beaches Council Community Engagement Strategy (2022).</p> <p>A project page¹ was established on our Have Your Say platform and included project information and the road reserve closure area plan.</p> <p>The project was primarily promoted through resident letter notifications, our Have Your Say community engagement newsletter, and on-site signage.</p> <p>Feedback was captured through an online submission form embedded onto the project page. An open-field comments box provided community members a space to share their comments. Email and written submissions were also invited. Contact details were provided should people have questions.</p>
