We will say **plan** for short.




The plan says how we will support **multicultural** people in the Northern Beaches.

About the plan



There are 2 big things in the plan that we want to work on.



The 2 things are

1. All people feel welcome in community spaces

2. Help multicultural people do the things they want to do.



We will tell you what we will do to make these 2 things happen.

1. All people feel welcome in community spaces



We want to make sure all people feel welcome in community spaces.



When we talked to multicultural people they said that everyone should be treated with respect.



They want to share what matters to them with everyone in the community.



They also told us that more multicultural people should work at Council.

This is what we want to do



We will support more events that show things that are important to multicultural people.



We will make sure community spaces help everyone feel welcome.



We will support the community to make sure everyone can join in.

2. Help multicultural people do the things they want to do



We want to make sure no one feels left out in our community.



Many multicultural people

- Speak other languages than English
- · Are still learning to speak English well.



They told us sometimes information can be hard to understand.



This might be information about support or things to do.



This makes it hard for some multicultural people to

• Get the support they need

• Join the things they would like to do.



Multicultural people also want to tell Council what they think about things.



They want to tell Council what matters to them in the community.

We will make sure Council information is in a way everyone can understand.

We will make sure multicultural people are part of decisions Council makes.




We want to have good relationships with multicultural people.
