Aquatic Flora

- The following images represent some of the plants and animals of the Freshwater Beach region.
- The Crayweed Project: Vast underwater forests have gone missing from the Sydney coastline. Scientists at Operation Crayweed have developed a method to create Crayweed forests by transplanting healthy Crayweed onto rocks where they were once dominant. The project uses biodegradable mesh which is drilled into rocks. The mesh supports healthy Crayweed growth.
- Freshwater Beach is a location where the Crayweed project has been successfully implemented.




