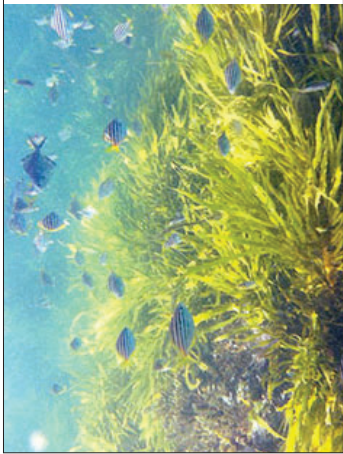


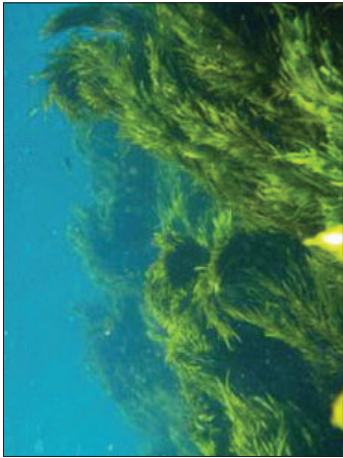
Playground Design - Theming Underwater at Freshwater

Aquatic Flora

- The following images represent some of the plants and animals of the Freshwater Beach region.
- The Crayweed Project: Vast underwater forests have gone missing from the Sydney coastline. Scientists at Operation Crayweed have developed a method to create Crayweed forests by transplanting healthy Crayweed onto rocks where they were once dominant. The project uses biodegradable mesh which is drilled into rocks.
- The mesh supports healthy Crayweed growth.
- Freshwater Beach is a location where the Crayweed project has been successfully implemented.



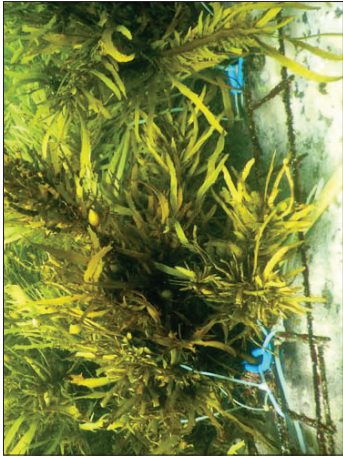

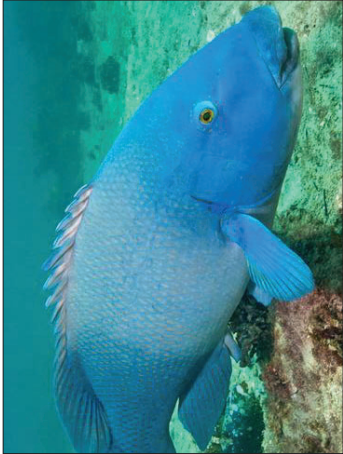

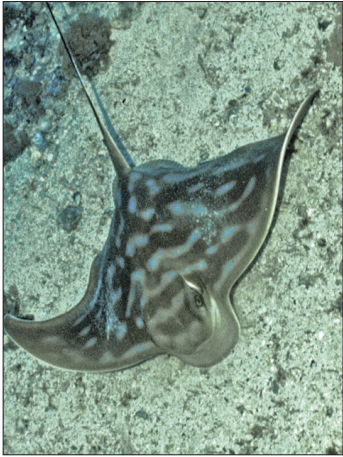
