

KEY FEATURES

- ① Entry: Provide reserve entry treatment including coloured concrete (CCS Canvas) threshold to meet flush with adjoining crossover & driveway, feature native low plantings, sandstone boulders and signage.
- ② Natural Area: Retain & protect existing native tree & understorey vegetation. Embellishment works including weed removal, mulching, supplementary locally native tree & groundcover plantings, possible Bushfood plantings.
- ③ Retain grass area over natural grassed bank
- ④ Seating space
- ⑤ Embankment Slide with wetpour rubber safety surfacing
- ⑥ Expose natural rock retaining wall: Sandstone steps / climbing wall & feature planting to embankment
- ⑦ Swing Area: Bird's nest seat set in wetpour / mulch safety surfacing
- ⑧ Vertical Garden Trellis: Timber post with stainless steel wire support for growing climbers, 500mm setback from boundary fence. Provides softening & separation to adjoining properties
- ⑨a Native hedge plantings along northern boundary eg. Tea Tree / Callistemon
- ⑨b Low native grasses & groundcovers
